It's long and tangy, with a lustrous presence of crystalline flavour that plays down the palate towards a bracingly brisk and frisky finish. Long and balanced, it's underpinned by a faint minerality.

Sparta is from Galaxidia vineyard, planted in 1998, and surrounded by olive trees. This is a classic McLaren Vale Shiraz. The Sparta is a fruit driven Shiraz made to enjoy in its youth through will cellar well. Tannis are soft and approachable with great fruit length.

# Pinot Noir

This variety seem to attract the most colorful descriptions from many a wine writer and enthusiast. Burgundy, where this grape possibly expresses "terroir" better than any other, is undoubtedly the ultimate benchmark. It typically shows dark berries to stewed plums on the nose underlined by truffles, fungal or barn yard tones. The mouth feel is rich and full, held up by tannins that are silky smooth, balanced with subtle oak and acid.
